Subject: MCST Science & Technology Festival 2010 – On-line registration open



The Malta Council for Science and Technology is currently leading the *Science Popularisation Campaign*, a project which is being co-financed by the EU's European Social Fund. The project's main aim is to encourage people to be more interested in and knowledgeable about Science and Technology. This should in turn have a positive impact on the take up of Science subjects in Secondary Schools and Higher Education.

The *S&T Festival 2010* will follow last year's successful on-campus extravaganza and is set for Monday 25th until Sunday 31st October at the University of Malta. The *S&T Festival 2010* is expected to attract 10,000 visitors, including students from Primary and Secondary Schools and the general public. The main content of the *S&T Festival 2010* includes a range of hands-on Science exhibits, Science shows and stands, live experiments in open labs, guided tours and 30-minute talks from field experts.

The opening hours are from **08:30 hrs to 15:00 hrs** from **Monday to Friday** for school visits (*strictly by registration*), and the following times, for the general public over the weekend: Friday 17:30 hrs - 22:00 hrs, Saturday 10:00 hrs - 22:00 hrs and Sunday 10:00 hrs - 19:00 hrs.

Primary School students in Years 4, 5, 6 & 7 and all Secondary School students are being invited to attend. Kindly register online by following the appropriate link. Only online registrations will be accepted.

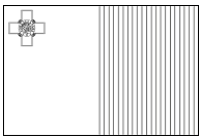

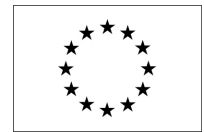
